September 6, 1620 Mayflower leaves  
Plymouth, England

November 9, 1620 Cape Cod sighted

November 11, 1620 Mayflower lands at  
Cape Cod; Mayflower Compact signed

November 28, 1620 Captain Standish and  
others explore coast in a shallop

December 20, 1620 Colonists spend first  
night in Plymouth, Massachusetts

April 5, 1621 Mayflower returns to  
Plymouth, England

The first Thanksgiving was celebrated  
during the second winter spent in  
Massachusetts. Governor William Bradford  
declared December 13, 1621 a day of  
feasting.
